Bio-Sketch:

Dr. Frazier has over 32 years of health physics experience in external and internal dosimetry, environmental dose assessment, radiation risk assessment, radiation spectroscopy, health physics training, bioassay, radiation detection and measurement, and radiological site characterization. He has worked as a health physicist for the U.S. FDA Bureau of Radiological Health (1977-1980), Oak Ridge Associated Universities (1980-1986), IT Corporation (1986-1993), and Auxier & Associates (1993-2004). Since November 2004, John has worked as an independent health physics consultant to private companies and individuals on numerous health physics issues. He has served as an expert witness in Federal and state court on matters pertaining to radiation dosimetry, radiation dose and risk assessments, and radiological characterization of land and facilities.
